
Ongoza is an Entrepreneur Support Organisation that provides customised advice, expertise, and guidance to young, ambitious entrepreneurs.





- Practical tools and techniques in building a customer base, establishing a product-market fit and increasing sales.
- Peer support, one on one mentorship and coaching
- A grant to a select few who are then linked to a growth partner for a period of 1 year to ensure proper grant utilization
